Without the proof of debt, the state of NY is unable to trace the original debt that was satisfied by this offset. OAG MFCU is unable to recoup funds from the entity responsible for the debt. According to the Treasury Offset Program, it is the federal government's responsibility to send the proof of debt to the state comptroller who has requested this multiple times.
